

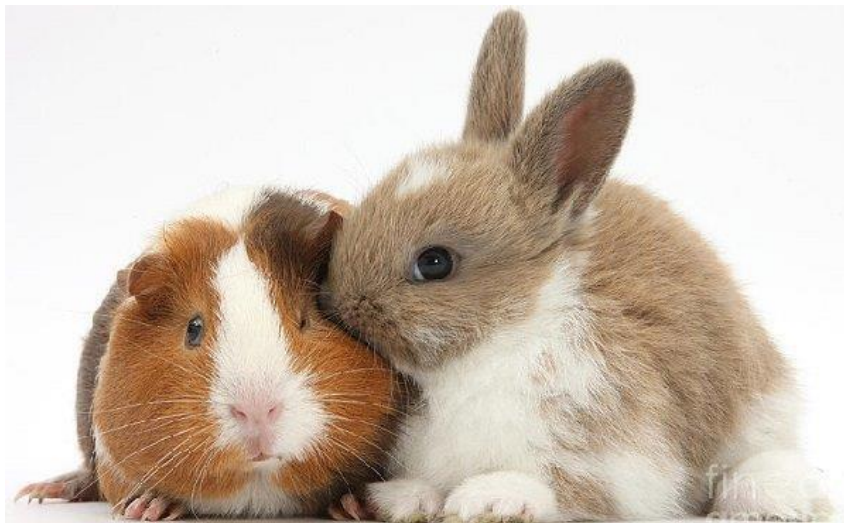
First Annual MA 4-H Rabbit Program

Rules and Regulations

1. The contest is open to all MA 4-H Rabbit Members ages 5-18 as of January 1, 2019.
2. All entries must be original creations of the contestant that incorporates the Official 4-H Clover into the design, has never been published, and does not contain profanity, trademarks, or copyrighted works of any other person or business.
3. There is no limit to the number of designs you can enter.
4. The prize is a free t-shirt with the winning design.
5. The entries must be received by email, or by mail by 5:00pm on Friday, January 18, 2019
6. Forms of Entries:
 - a. The entry should be accompanied by your name and contact information
 - b. The entry may be drawn or printed on 8.5" x 11" paper or submitted electronically as .jpg or .pdf.
7. Winning entry will be voted on at the 2019 MA 4-H Rabbit Workshop on January 26, 2019. Winner does not have to be present.
8. We reserve the right to pick one entry, more than one entry, or no entries as the winning entry.
