
First Annual MA 4-H Rabbit Program

- 4. The prize is a free t-shirt with the winning design.
- 5. The entries must be received by email, or by mail by 5:00pm on Friday, January 18, 2019
- 6. Forms of Entries:
 - a. The entry should be accompanied by your name and contact information
 - b. The entry may be drawn or printed on 8.5" x 11" paper or submitted electronically as .jpg or .pdf.
- Winning entry will be voted on at the 2019 MA 4-H Rabbit Workshop on January 26, 2019. Winner does not have to be present.
- 8. We reserve the right to pick one entry, more than one entry, or no entries as the winning entry.
